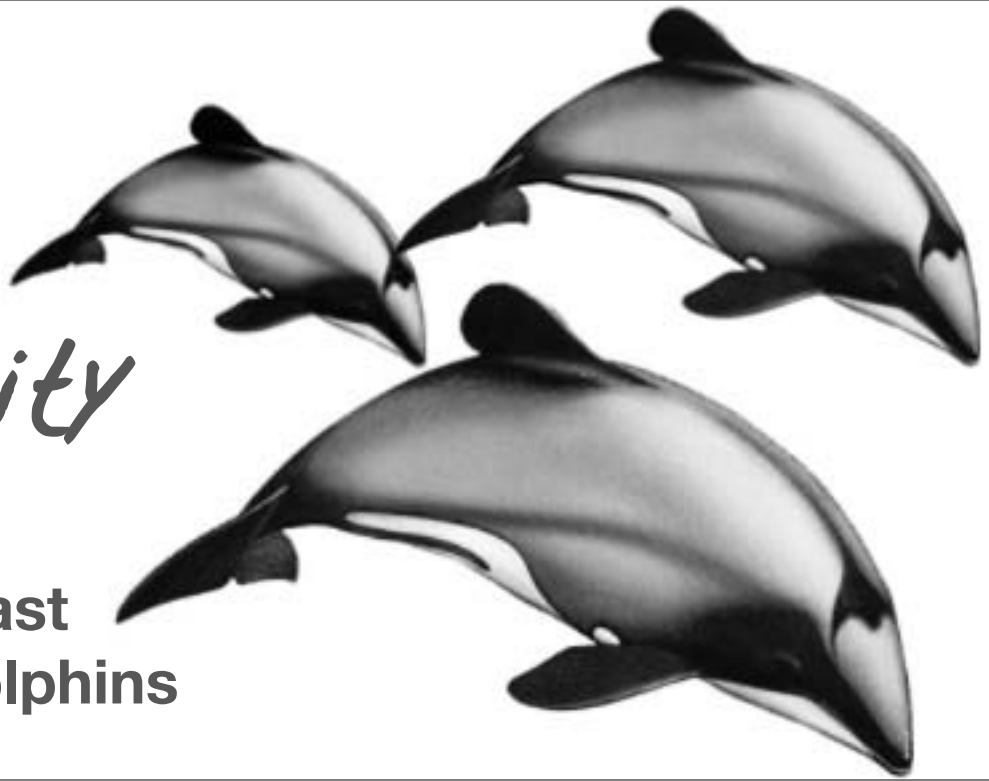

Why care? Gill and trawl nets have picked off Hector's and Maui's dolphins for decades because their habitat is not properly protected. Some 23,000 Hector's dolphins have died already and there are just over 7,000 left. Off the North Island a mere 55 adult Maui's dolphins are fighting for survival. Unless things change, they will be the first marine cetacean to go extinct because of human actions. The fate of the world's smallest and rarest marine dolphin is at stake and so is New Zealand's reputation.
